VINI E PROSECCO

VINO BIANCO £7 | £9.5 | £26

Zibbibo, a rounded and elegant Sicilian white wine from organic vineyards

VINO ROSSO £7 | £9.5 | £26

Nero d'Avola, the most important grape in Sicily. Notoriously drinkable

VINO ROSATO £7 | £9.5 | £26

Pinot Grigot grape, aromatic with delicate citrus notes. Refreshing and well balanced

VINO DEL MESE £8 | £10 | £29

Merlot Bella Storia, Cielo e Terra, Veneto. Plum and dark cherry, cedar-wood aromas

PROSECCO £7 | £9 | £32

Prima Alto. Fresh & light on the palate, notes of peach & green apple

PROSECCO ROSATO £7 | £9 | £32

Prima Alto. Light & refreshing. Classic prosecco with a touch of sweetness

SPRITZ

APEROL SPRITZ £9.5

The after-work spritz of choice for many Italians. Prosecco, bitter orange and soda

NEGRONI SPAGLIATO £9.5

'Spagliato' meaning mistake, a Negroni that uses sparkling wine instead of gin

SPRITZ HUGO £9.5

Prosecco, gin, elderflower, mint & soda. Refreshing, floral & herbal

LIMONCELLO SPRITZ £9.5

Made with limoncello from Amalfi, prosecco & soda

WINES BY THE BOTTLE

SOAVE 2020, AGOSTINO VENETO (WHITE), £38

A producer specialising in Soave & Valpolicella, Agostino has recently become certified organic. Late harvested, it has a full and waxy mouthfeel, and a palate displaying fresh peach, apricot and orange peel!

GRECO DI TUFO 2022, FERRARA CAMPAGNIA (WHITE) £45

Volcanic wine. Here, to the East of Naples and Mount Vesuvius, we find Greco di Tufo. The volcanic soils allow the vines to produce wines full of fragrance and body.

NERO D'AVOLA 2021, PLANETA SICILIA (RED) £28

Planeta are one of the island's foremost wine producers and their example, from NW Sicily, is no different. Cocoa, spices and dark fruits mingle on the palate.

ST MAGDALENER 2022 COLTERENZINO, ALTO ADIGE (RED), £32

Grown in an Alpine-Mediterranean climate, this delightful red wine is made by a quality focussed cooperative using the Schiava grape variety. Juicy with aromas of violets and bursting with dark cherry and plum.

VALPOLICELLA 2017, AGOSTINO VENETO (RED) £50

Love Amarone, love this Valpolicella Superiore! After a traditional grape drying process, the wine is aged for 18 months in large barrels. This combination results in a full bodied wine, with silky, sweet tannins.

MOSCATO D'ASTI 2023, TACCHINO PIEMONTE (SPARKLING) £25

Slightly sweet, low alcohol and sparkling. Moscato D'Asti had been made in Piemonte for 150 years and is only produced in small batches, by artisanal wineries. Bright citrus fruit flavours and a honeyed finish.
